The end product is a vial of blood which has been separated into 3 parts, red blood cells, platelet rich plasma and platelet poor plasma. The red blood cells are discarded and the plasma is prepared for redistribution by injection or microneedling to the desired area. Platelets play a vital role in tissue repair and regeneration and PRP injections have been used throughout many disciplines for many years, in particular in acute sports injuries involving ligament and muscle damage repair.
