Examples may include: Acid reducers like the H2 blocker Pepcid (famotidine) Stool softeners and stimulant laxatives like Peri-Colace (docusate sodium/sennosides) Anti-nausea medications like Zofran (ondansetron)

Anticoagulant medication prevents the blood from clotting, which can cause serious problems in such cases. Naturally, the answers to these questions vary widely by patient and must be evaluated on a case by case basis.

Can I Take My Prescribed Medications Before Oral Surgery?

- All analgesics can be given before surgery - EXCEPT NSAID'S (see below) OMIT
- ACE inhibitors (ramipril, enalapril, perindopril, captopril)
- Angiotensin 2 antagonists (candesartan, losartan)
- o Both these drugs may drop the blood pressure during an anaesthetic.
- o Anaesthetists may request that these drugs are given before surgery but this will be requested on an individual basis.

Drugs that should be stopped before surgery include combined oral contraceptives, see Contraceptives, hormonal; for advice on hormone replacement therapy, see Sex hormones. MAOIs can have important interactions with some drugs used during surgery, such as pethidine hydrochloride. Tricyclic antidepressants need not be stopped, but there may be an increased risk of arrhythmias and hypotension (and dangerous interactions with vasopressor drugs); therefore, the anaesthetist should be informed if ...

Today, the most popular class of medications for IV sedation in the dental office are a class of drugs known as the benzodiazepines, with midazolam (Versed) probably one the most often used.

Midazolam acts quickly and wears off faster than some of the older benzodiazepines — Valium (diazepam) and Ativan (lorazepam), for example, which are still used for oral sedation — making it a safer and more useful medication.

Bromfenac is used for the treatment of postoperative inflammation following cataract surgery. Diclofenac sodium and flurbiprofen are also used to prevent miosis during ocular surgery. Apraclonidine, an alpha 2 -adrenoreceptor agonist, reduces intra-ocular pressure possibly by reducing the production of aqueous humour.

Antibiotics such as penicillin and amoxicillin (Amoxil) are used for a variety of infections that may result after dental procedures. Erythromycin (Benzamycin, Emgel, Ery, Ilotycin, Staticin) is usually prescribed when patients have allergies to penicillin or amoxicillin (Amoxil).

Managing Pain With Medications After Orthopaedic Surgery ...

Some of the commonly utilized narcotics include morphine, fentanyl, hydromorphone (Dilaudid®), meperidine (Demerol®) and oxycodone (OxyContin®). Anesthesiologists administer these drugs intra-operative (during surgery) and post-operatively (after surgery) to help control pain.
